Teaching Related General Guidelines

Total Number of all theory Lectures assigned as per CBCS, University of Delhi Revised Syllabus for Management Accounting are 65. One tutorial per week per batch is to be taken. Unit-wise breakup of 65 Lectures and marks allocation were decided as follows:

Unit wise detailed guidelines were finalized as follow.

Unit 1: Introduction: The unit contains all theoretical topics.

Unit 2 &3: Marginal Costing &Decision Making: Small theatrical questions may be asked along with practical questions. However, emphasis will on teaching practical aspects of the topics covered in the units as mentioned in the course outcomes.

Unit 4: Budgetary Control and Standard Costing System: Small theatrical questions from budgetary control and standard costing system can be asked along with practical questions. However, emphasis will on teaching practical aspects of the topics covered in the units. In standard costing all variances including material, labour, overheads and sales are to be covered. Only theoretical aspects of master budget will be covered

Unit 5: Performance Measurement: Theoretical aspects of all the topics covered in the unit. However small practical questions may be asked on the financial measures for performance measurement.
